From the Pastor

Counting Others Above Ourselves

“Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves” (Philippians 2:3).

Every day we face a choice. Will we live for ourselves, or will we intentionally put others first? Paul reminds believers that, as citizens of heaven, we are called to live differently. Instead of pursuing recognition or personal gain, we are to reflect Christ's humble mindset. In Philippians 2:3, Paul clearly outlines a simple principle for us to follow.

- 1. **Motive Matters.** When we perform acts of kindness, provide service, or build relationships, we must be mindful of hidden agendas. Too often, people do things for others hoping to receive something in return. God cares not only about what we do but also why we do it.
- 2. **Conceit Destroys.** Conceit is empty pride. It convinces us we are more important than we are and quietly damages our relationships. Paul reminds us not to think more highly of ourselves than we should (Romans 12:3). Humility preserves unity; pride tears it apart (Galatians 5:26).
- 3. **Count Others First.** Humility is not weakness. It is a defining characteristic of every follower of Christ. It is the posture of love. We will never love or serve as Jesus did until we willingly humble ourselves and place others’ needs before our own (John 13:1–17).

My prayer this month is that the Lord will help each of us cultivate the mind of Christ. As we set aside selfish ambition, reject empty pride, and count others as more significant than ourselves, we will reflect Christ's love to one another and to our community.
